

The Great Scavenger Hunt of 2020

Contest Details, Rules, Regulations, and Eligibility to Win:

- 1) Register online at Mount Engadine Lodge by October 16 to participate.
 - a) Registration is \$10.00 and includes a bagged lunch
- 2) Pick up your bagged lunch & sign waiver form & get the first clue at the lodge on October 17th.
- 3) Follow the @MountEngadine, @CarmellaConsulting and participating businesses accounts to be eligible to win.
 - a) We will be checking your account if you should win to ensure you are following the participation rules. Your account MUST be public for the contest timeframe.
- 4) Share your journey in your Instagram Story and Instagram Posts and tag the local businesses (be careful to not reveal the clue or others may beat you to the prize!) for more chances to win. Prize pack #4 will be for the best photo (must be posted on Instagram Feed). Winner chosen on Monday, October 19th
- 5) Make sure to use #EngadineScavengerHunt
- 6) When you come to receive your prize at the lodge, we will be checking to make sure that you completed all of the rules and regulations.
- 7) This is a "choose your own adventure" scavenger hunt. Initial clues will lead participants to choose their own route: Easy, medium, or hard. Routes will include km, elevation gain and if it's family friendly so participants know the best route to choose for their group.
- 8) Participants may only win one prize pack.
- 9) Prizes are hidden in the Mount Engadine Lodge area (~15km radius max).
- 10) Registration to participate is open from 8AM 11AM ONLY to give participants enough time to find the clues before dusk. Day of registration requires participants to "check-in" at the lodge, sign a waiver and pick up their first clue. Participants must be back by 7:00PM.
- 11) All participants are required to carry bear spray and we will provide a packing list *see below
- 12) All participants are in charge of their own safety and wellbeing. Mount Engadine, Carmella Consulting and all participating businesses are not responsible for the safety and wellbeing of participants. All participants are acting on their own behalf and are responsible for their own safety during the scavenger hunt. *waiver will be signed at Mount Engadine Lodge
- 13) Please remember that there is limited cell phone reception in the Mount Engadine/ Kananaskis area.

Packing guide:

- Bear spray (lodge will have some for sale for those who forget)
- Adequate footwear and clothing (layers)
- Water and snacks (bagged lunch provided)
- Phone or Camera to take pictures of clues at locations they find
